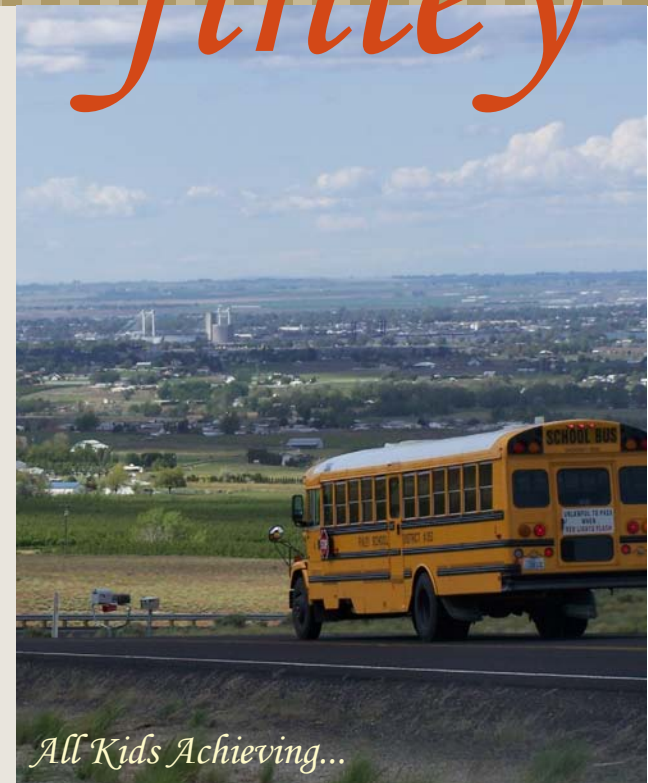
Finley School District
