

Summer Meals Program (Open June – August)

The Washington State Summer Food Service Program (also known as the Summer Meals Program) is one of the federal nutrition programs that provides **free meals and snacks to children and teens during the summer months** (June through August). Summer meal sites are located in schools, parks, recreation centers, community-based organizations, faith-based organizations, and camps. In addition to meals, many sites provide fun activities for kids. Sites may be open from June through August, depending on your community.

All kids and teens (18 years old and younger) are eligible for the program. No proof of income, address or citizenship is ever required.
